Project Description:

1996 – BLM OHV Online Information System, The BLM On-Line Information System project involves the development of contract labor and in-house graphic, computer and recreation staff assistance, a series of interrelated home pages will be developed. The information will be linked to other Arizona recreation, tourism and OHV "Net" sites as well as to Tread Lightly and other national OHV related BLM information. The activity (interest) generated by the on-line sites will be monitored and shared with the Arizona OHV community at workshops and seminars., Grant Cost \$12,000.

2003 – AZ OHV Multi- Agency Education Project, The project will develop an education curricular that addresses safety, technical ability, land use ethics, recreational opportunities and other identified needs. It will be presented by the Arizona Natural Resource Conservation Districts in school classrooms and at family OHV education events, and to user groups throughout the seven counties in the project area. Maps, trail signs, a billboard and flyers will assist in delivering the message. Kiosk will be installed in the Kingman (28) and Yuma (1) Field Office areas and at the Boulders (1) OHV area. Grant amount \$114,375.

#571108 (2011) – OHV Ambassador Program, Grant amount \$163,800.

#551607 (2016) – Travel Management Planning and Implementation, AZ BLM proposes to develop 5 travel management plans (TMP) over the next 12 months. Provide and install (3100 route markers) signs upon official route designation, provide maps and trail information to benefit connectivity, rock crawling, long distance touring and loop opportunities. Grant amount \$489,290.
