Project Description:

Moss Wash OHV Trail, Sleeping Princess OHV Trail, Route 66 Back Country Byway, Black Mountains and Hualapai Mountains Access Routes. Moss Wash OHV Trail - Install metal ramada kiosk at the trailhead and 20 trail markers along the trail. Labor performed by BLM recreation staff and Bullhead 4 Wheelers (volunteers).

Sleeping Princess OHV Trail - Install metal ramada kiosk at the trailhead. Labor performed by BLM staff and Walapai 4 Wheelers (volunteers).

Route 66 Back Country Byway - Replace Rt. 66 BCB signs at the kiosk. Kiosk is located on Rt. 66 adjacent to a heavily used disperse ATV area outside of Golden Shores, AZ. Labor to be performed by BLM recreation staff.

Black Mountains and Hualapai Mountains Bulletin Boards (Kiosks) - Replace Plexiglas and plywood on bulletin boards located along access routes into the Black Mtns. and Hualapai Mtns. Area. Labor performed by BLM Recreation.
